Dear Parents and Guardians,

On Friday, December 18, 2020, the Delano Joint Union High School District Board of Trustees approved several revisions to our School Reopening Plan. Due to increased COVID-19 transmission rates throughout the Central Valley, the Delano Joint Union High School District has opted to continue with all students on a distance learning platform.

While we understand that it is important to have students return to campuses as quickly as possible for in person instruction, the overall safety and wellbeing of our students, staff, and community is our first priority.

The revised plan outlines the details for a phased in reopening model for the District that is tentatively scheduled to begin on March 1, 2021. This targeted reopening date for Phase 1 may be adjusted as a result of changing conditions in our community due to the impact of COVID-19. Please let me assure you, that we will continue to closely monitor the County's COVID-19 data and all reopening procedures will adhere to the California Department of Public Health's recommended safety guidelines for schools.

Within the plan, you will find a schedule for the phased in reopening model and the applicable safety and instructional protocols for staff and students. I would like to thank everyone for their continued support and understanding as we are working diligently to provide a safe and engaging learning environment for all students.
