Please follow these steps:

1. In your web browser please type in the following link:

2. Click the file name: Robert F. Kennedy Spring 2018 Athletic Registration
3. Next click on the green **Register Now** button and scroll, if necessary, to the **Create Account/Log In** green buttons. If this is your first time using FamilyID, click **Create Account**. Click **Log In**, if you already have a FamilyID account.
4. **Create** your secure FamilyID account by entering the account owner First and Last names (parent/guardian), E-mail address and password. Select **I Agree** to the FamilyID Terms of Service. Click **Create Account**.
5. You will receive an email with a link to activate your new account. (If you don't see the email, check your E-mail filters (spam, junk, etc.).)
6. Click on the link in your activation E-mail, which will log you in to FamilyID.com
7. Once in the registration form, complete the information requested. All fields with a red* are **required have an answer**.
8. Click the **Continue** button when your form is complete.
9. Review your registration summary.

At any time, you may login at www.familyid.com to update your information and to check your registration(s). To view a completed registration, select the "Registration" tab on the blue bar.
