#### The Kidney Stone & Soda Connection

The most common cause of kidney stones is **dehydration**.

Soda drinkers generally don't drink enough water, and soda is not effective in keeping people hydrated.

Researchers also found that **phosphorus** can increase the risk of kidney stones. Many sodas contain **phosphoric acid**. A study found that people who agreed to stop drinking soda decreased their chance of developing more kidney sones


